

**RESOLUTION NO. 2002-18 R**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM TEXAS ENGINEERING EXTENSION SERVICE, TEXAS TASK FORCE 1, AND THE CITY OF VICTORIA TO DELINEATE RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROVIDE FOR FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) REIMBURSEMENT OF PAYROLL COSTS FOR CITY PERSONNEL DEPLOYED FOR URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE ACTIVITIES AND EXECUTE OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR SUCH REIMBURSEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

On May 15, 2001, by Resolution No. 2001-81R, the City Administration approved the agreement between the Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) and Texas Task Force One (TTF-1) to accept a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the reimbursement of payroll costs for two employees during deployment for urban search and rescue activities by the members of Texas Task Force One, and this process now needs to allow for three employees to be reimbursed for said activities.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

The City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the Texas A&M University System Texas Engineering Extension Service, Texas Task Force 1, and the City of Victoria to delineate responsibilities and provide for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) reimbursement of payroll costs for City personnel deployed for urban search and rescue activities and execute other documents necessary for such reimbursement, all in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


