

**ORDINANCE NO. 2002- 5**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CAMERON STREET BETWEEN COMMERCIAL STREET AND STAYTON AVENUE TO PUBLIC VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PLACE SUCH TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT SAID CROSSING AS ARE APPROPRIATE TO DISCOURAGE PUBLIC VEHICULAR TRAFFIC; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

Cameron Street between Commercial Street and Stayton Avenue, and Commercial Street at Navarro and Stayton Avenue at Navarro are hereby closed to public vehicular traffic, and the Director of Public Works is authorized to place such traffic control devices at said crossing as the Director, in his sole discretion, determines are appropriate to discourage such public vehicular traffic.

2.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

3.

If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and adoption by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas.




