

RESOLUTION NO. 2002- 59 R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RELIANT ENERGY - ENTEX FOR THE RELOCATION OF AN EXISTING 4" NATURAL GAS PIPELINE IN AIRLINE ROAD BETWEEN NAVARRO STREET AND ARROYO STREET FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000.00; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The City Council finds that this contract is exempt from the requirements for competitive bidding because (1) pursuant to Tex. Local Gov't Code §252.022(2), it is a procurement necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents because it will be avoiding conflicts between a sewer line currently being installed and a gas line, (2) pursuant to Tex. Local Gov't Code §252.022(7), a procurement of gas, water or utility services that are available from only one source, and (3) the possible inapplicability of Chapter 252 thereto;

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with Reliant Energy-Entex for the relocation of an existing 4" natural gas pipeline in Airline Road between Navarro Street and Arroyo Street, in a form approved by the City Attorney, in a total amount not to exceed \$90,000.00.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


