

ORDINANCE NO. 2002 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S SCHEDULES OF ONE-WAY STREETS, PARKING RESTRICTIONS, AND SPEED LIMITS TO ESTABLISH DEAN COOK STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET DURING SPECIFIED MORNING AND AFTERNOON SCHOOL PICK-UP/DROP-OFF TIMES; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00 UPON CONVICTION; REPEALING PARTS OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

Schedule II, "One Way Streets in School Zones," of the City's Schedules of One Way Streets, Parking Restrictions, and Speed Limits, which was adopted on August 21, 2001, is amended to add Section (6), which will read as follows:

(6) **Dean Cook Street**, from Leary Lane to Mockingbird Lane.

2.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined any sum not to exceed \$200.00.

3.

All parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4.

If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

5.

The City Secretary shall publish the caption or a descriptive title of this Ordinance one time within 10 days after final passage of the Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Victoria in accordance with Article II, § 10 of the City Charter.

6.

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective 10 days after final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas.


