

ORDINANCE NO. 2003 2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S SCHEDULES OF ONE-WAY STREETS, PARKING RESTRICTIONS, AND SPEED LIMITS TO ESTABLISH NO PARKING ZONES ON KING ARTHUR AT NAVARRO AND REMOVE A NO PARKING ZONE ON MANTZ BETWEEN GOODWIN AND CONSTITUTION; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00 UPON CONVICTION; SUSPENDING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

Schedule III of the City's Schedules of One Way Streets, Parking Restrictions, and Speed Limits, which was adopted on August 21, 2001, and governs areas on which parking is prohibited at all times in accordance with Section 22-61 of the Victoria City Code, is amended to add Section (45), which shall provide as follows:

In accordance with Section 22-61 of the Victoria City Code, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon . . .

(45) **King Arthur**, from its intersection with Navarro to a point approximately 350' to the east.

2.

Schedule III of the City's Schedules of One Way Streets, Parking Restrictions, and Speed Limits, which was adopted on August 21, 2001, and governs areas on which parking is prohibited at all times in accordance with Section 22-61 of the Victoria City Code, is amended to delete Section (22) which prohibits parking on part of Mantz Street.

3.

All parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are suspended to the extent of such conflict.

4.

If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

5.

The City Secretary shall publish the caption or a descriptive title of this Ordinance one time within 10 days after final passage of the Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Victoria in accordance with Article II, § 10 of the City Charter.

6.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective 10 days after final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas and shall cease to be effective on February 19, 2003.


