

RESOLUTION NO. 2003 101 R

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate a Juvenile Justice Accountability Incentive Block Grant from the Texas Governor's Criminal Justice Division via the Golden Crescent Regional Planning Commission (GCRPC) in the amount of \$24,853.00 from the state with a local match in an amount not to exceed \$2,761.00, and declaring an effective date.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

The City Manager is authorized to execute all documents necessary to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate a Juvenile Justice Accountability Incentive Block Grant, in a form approved by the City Attorney, from the Texas Governor's Criminal Justice Division via the Golden crescent Regional Planning Commission (GCRPC), of up to \$24,853.00 from the state with a local match in an amount not to exceed \$2,761.00, and

The City Council:

1. finds it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Victoria, Texas that the aforementioned program be operated for the years for which it is designated,
2. has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the aforementioned grant,
3. agrees to provide the minimum matching percentage for the this project as required by the grant application for the aforementioned grant, and
4. agrees that, in the event of loss or misuse of funds of the Texas Governor's Criminal Justice Division (CJD), the funds will be returned to CJD in full.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

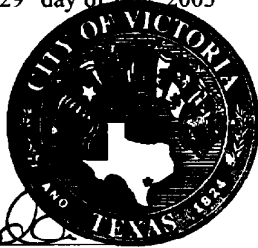
