A RESOLUTION AWARDDING A BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN FOUR-DOOR POLICE PACKAGE PATROL SEDANS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,890 APIECE AND THREE FOUR-DOOR POLICE ADMINISTRATION SEDANS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,718 APIECE TO LAWRENCE MARSHALL DEALERSHIPS OF HEMPSTEAD, TEXAS, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$208,384.00 (ALL VEHICLES ARE FORD CROWN VICTORIA); AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

The City Administration is authorized to accept the bid for the purchase of seven four-door police package patrol sedans in the amount of \$20,890 apiece, and three four-door police administration sedans in the amount of \$20,718 apiece from Lawrence Marshall Dealerships of Hempstead, Texas, in the total amount of \$208,384.00.

The City Manager is authorized to execute contracts with the aforementioned entity for the purchases of the above-referenced items, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, in accordance with the bid specifications.


