

ORDINANCE NO. 2004- 2005

An ordinance approving and adopting a budget for operating the municipal government of the City of Victoria for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2004, and ending on September 30, 2005; appropriating money for the various funds and purposes of such budget including appropriations of money to pay interest and principal sinking fund requirements on all indebtedness; repealing all conflicting ordinances and appropriations; providing for severability; and declaring an effective date.

A budget for operating the municipal government of the City of Victoria for the fiscal year October 1, 2004, to September 30, 2005, has been submitted to the City Council by the City Manager in accordance with Texas Local Government Code § 102.006, other applicable law, and the City Charter;

Public notice of a public hearing upon this budget was ordered by resolution of the City Council on August 10, 2004, and this public hearing was held upon the budget on August 31, 2004, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 107 W. Juan Linn, Victoria, Texas, and the City Council finds that after full and final consideration of proposed expenditures, revenues, financial condition, and comparative expenditures was presented, the budget as finally considered at said hearing shall be approved and adopted.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

I.

The City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas officially closes all public hearings in regard to the following budget, and approves and adopts the budget for the City of Victoria's 2004-2005 Fiscal Year as described in detail in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all intents and purposes, and described in general as follows:

The appropriations for the 2004-2005 fiscal year for the different administrative units and purposes of the City of Victoria, Texas are fixed and determined for said fiscal year in accordance with the expenditures shown in said budget, and the distribution and division of said appropriations shall be made in accordance with said budget including such amounts shown for providing for sinking funds for the payment of the principal and interest and the retirement of the bonded debt of the City of Victoria.

An original copy of the City of Victoria 2004-2005 Fiscal Year Budget described above as **Exhibit "A"** shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Finance Director, the City Secretary, and the Victoria County Clerk as provided by state law and City Charter.

4.

All ordinances and appropriations or parts of ordinances and appropriations in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

5.

If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

6.

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas.


