

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-2007-M

An ordinance amending the 2006-2007 Fiscal Year Budget of the City of Victoria to provide funding for the automated garbage collection program and waste-disposal-related professional services by transferring \$335,000 from the Environmental Services Closure Fund fund balance to two Environmental Services line items and transferring \$260,000 from the VES Fund fund balance to the VES Fund Vehicles Capital line item; repealing all conflicting ordinances, providing for severability, and declaring an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

The Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Budget of the City of Victoria is amended to provide funding for the automated garbage collection program and waste-disposal-related professional services by transferring:

\$335,000 from the Environmental Services Closure Fund fund balance (4045-300100) to the:

Environmental Services Fund Capital Replacement line item 4045-45SOL-590020 in the amount of \$260,000, and

Environmental Services Fund Recycling Professional Services line item 4045-45RCY-530000 in the amount of \$75,000, and \$260,000 from the VES Fund fund balance (5051-300100) to the VES Fund Vehicles Capital line item (5051-51VES-950100).

2.

If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4.

In accordance with Article V, Section 5 of the Charter of the City of Victoria, the City Council finds a grave public necessity exists to amend the original budget to authorize the aforementioned expenditures to meet unusual and unforeseen conditions, which could not by reasonable diligence, thought, and attention have been included in the original budget.

5.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final approval and adoption by the City Council of the City of Victoria.




