

RESOLUTION NO. 2009- 113 R

A resolution authorizing the City Administration to accept the bids for annual supply contracts of (1) Altivia Corporation, of Houston, Texas, for Liquid Chlorine in the amount of \$569.00 per ton container for a total of approximately \$68,280.00, (2) General Chemical, of Parsippany, New Jersey, for Liquid Phosphate-Based Corrosion Inhibitor in the amount of \$940.00 per liquid ton for a total of approximately \$70,500.00, (3) Kemira Water Solution, of Lawrence, Kansas, for Ferrous Chloride in the amount of \$280.00 per liquid ton for a total of approximately \$70,000.00, (4) International Dioxide of North Kingston, Rhode Island, for Liquid Sodium Chlorite in the amount of \$870.00 per liquid ton for a total of approximately \$104,400.00, and (5) Kemira Water Solution, of Lawrence, Kansas, for Liquid Ferrous Sulfate in the amount of \$120.00 per liquid ton for a total of approximately \$48,000.00; and declaring an effective date.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

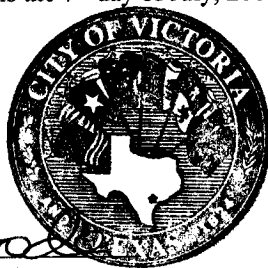




