A resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to apply for the Texas Department of Transportation 2009 Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program Call for Projects, in the approximate amounts of (1) \$888,322.00 with a 20% City match of \$177,665.00, which will be used for the Red River Corridor Enhancement Project, and (2) \$486,000.00 with a 20% City match of \$97,200.00, which will be used for the Jim Branch Outfall Trail Project; and declaring an effective date.
