

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-220 R

A resolution authorizing the City Administration to execute an Application for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009: Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Formula Grant (JAG) Program for the purchase of portable 800MHz digital radios for the Police Department, in the total amount of \$409,925.00, with no City matching funds required, and authorizing the City Administration to execute all documents necessary to accept said grant and to satisfy all requirements of the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division; and declaring an effective date.

On September 8, 2009, by Resolution No. 2009-151R, the City Council approved the application and the acceptance of this grant. In order to receive and satisfy all requirements for this grant as required by the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, the City hereby accepts and approves the following:

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

WHEREAS, the Victoria City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Victoria, that the Communications Equipment Upgrade Project to be operated for the year 2010; and

2.

WHEREAS, the Victoria City Council agrees to provide for the said project as required by the 2009 Edward Byrne Grant application; and

3.

WHEREAS, the Victoria City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Victoria City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

4.

WHEREAS, the Victoria City Council designates the Deputy City Manager as the Grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Victoria City Council approves submission of the grant application for the Communications Equipment Upgrade to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division. Grant Application Confirmation Number: 2268801.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
