

ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 13

An ordinance amending Section 24-91 of the Victoria City Code to revise Community Center fees, repealing conflicting parts of existing ordinances, providing for severability, providing for codification and savings, and declaring an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

Chapter 24, "Fees," of the Victoria City Code is amended to amend Section 24-91 to read as follows:

Sec. 24-91. Regulations and Rental Rates for Community Center.

(a) The policies, category descriptions, and all other provisions contained in the "Victoria Community Center Regulations" ~~and Rental Rates~~ are approved, adopted, and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, a copy of which is on file with the City Secretary and the Parks and Recreation Director. Rental rates will be separated from the "Victoria Community Center Regulations" and any changes to rates will be approved and adopted by City Council as necessary. All future policies, category descriptions and provisions in the "Victoria Community Center Regulations" will be approved and adopted by the City Manager.

(b) Rental rates for the use of Community Center facilities are:

Dome (Mon. – Thurs.).....	\$750.00 <u>\$788.00</u> per day
Dome/weekend (Fri.-Sun.).....	\$900.00 <u>\$945.00</u> per day
Annex (Mon.-Thurs.).....	\$550.00 <u>\$578.00</u> per day
Annex/weekend (Fri.-Sun.).....	\$675.00 <u>\$709.00</u> per day
½ Annex (Mon.-Thurs.).....	\$350.00 <u>\$368.00</u> per day
½ Annex/weekend (Fri.-Sun.).....	\$425.00 <u>\$446.00</u> per day
Arena.....	\$450.00 <u>\$473.00</u> per day
Conference room.....	\$50.00 per day
Kitchen area next to the dome.....	\$150.00 per day
Kitchen area next to the annex.....	\$110.00 per day

Concession area next to the dome.....	\$200.00 per day
Early entry fee for any part of Community Center.....	\$50.00 <u>\$100.00</u> per hour

(c) ~~Down payments/Deposits. Cleaning and Damage Deposits Non-refundable down payment/deposit will be due 10 calendar days after issuance of contract. Cancellation for any reason will result in subject to forfeiture of the down payment/deposit. as per the terms of the "Victoria Community Center Regulations".~~

(e) Down payments. Non-Refundable 15% down payment will be due 10 calendar days after issuance of contract.

~~(e)~~ (f) Late Fees. A late payment of 10% of the contract will be assessed if the balance is not paid by the stated due date on the contract.

~~(f)~~ (g) With the approval of the City Manager, the Director of Parks and Recreation may:

- (1) determine rates for events scheduled more than two years after the date the reservation is made, and
- (2) offer reduced rates for selected seminars, conventions and meetings in accordance with the Victoria Community Center Regulations ~~and Rental Rates.~~

2.

All parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

3.

If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

4.

It is the intention of the City Council that this ordinance shall become a part of the Code of the City of Victoria, Texas, and it may be renumbered and codified therein accordingly, in the manner approved by the City Attorney. The Code of the City of Victoria, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

5.

This ordinance shall become effective 10 days after final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas.


