

RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 208 R

A resolution allocating funding to outside agencies from the 2010-2011 Hotel Occupancy Tax funds, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and the execution of a funding agreement with said agencies; and declaring an effective date.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, TEXAS:

1.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 26,000, to the Cultural Council of Victoria, Inc., for the purpose of the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and the execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

2.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 2,000, to the Museum of the Coastal Bend, a unit of The Victoria College, for the purpose of historical restoration and preservation projects or activities or advertising and conducting solicitations and promotional programs, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(5) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and the execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

3.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 4,000, to the Quilt Guild of Greater Victoria, Inc., for the purpose of advertising and conducting solicitations and promotional programs, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(3) of the Texas Tax Code and the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, specifically craft and folk art, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and the execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

4.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ -0-, to the Victoria Community Theatre d/b/a Theatre Victoria, for the purpose of the encouragement, promotion, improvement and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

5.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 15,000, to the Victoria Bach Festival Association, Inc., for the purpose of the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

6.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 22,000, to the Victoria Ballet Theatre, for the purpose of the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

7.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ 30,000, to the Victoria Regional Museum Association, Incorporated, for the purpose of advertising

and conducting solicitations and promotional programs, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(3) of the Texas Tax Code and the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

8.

The City Council hereby allocates from the City's 2010-2011 hotel occupancy tax funds, an amount not to exceed \$ **15,000** , to the Victoria Symphony Society, Inc., for the purpose of the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts, pursuant to Section 351.101(a)(4) of the Texas Tax Code, subject to the approval of a subsequent budget amendment and execution of a funding agreement with said agency.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
