

2009 International Fuel Gas Code

Sec. 5-90. Adoption of Published Code.

There is hereby adopted by the City for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the safe installation and maintenance of all natural gas piping and appliances, that certain code known as the International Fuel Gas Code, 2009 Edition, published by the International Code Council Inc., save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified, or amended, of which a copy is on file with the City Secretary and the Development Services Department, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this section shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling in the installation of gas piping systems therein contained within the corporate limits of the City.

Sec. 5-91. Definition.

Whenever the term “Building Official” is used in the gas code, it shall be held to mean director, as defined in Section 2-80.
