

Door to Door Solicitation

Door to door solicitation **must** be permitted with the City of Victoria.

- **Local vendors** must have a Commercial Outdoor Sales permit. This permit costs \$80.00.
- **Out of town vendors** must have an Itinerant Vendor permit costing \$80.00 and \$40.00 for a Police Investigation fee.
- **Charitable organizations** must have a Charitable Solicitation permit. There is no fee for this permit.



Miscellaneous Permits

Garage sales are allowed every six months at the same location. Permits are \$8.00 and are good for three consecutive days. Now available online www.victoriatx.org credit card and printer required.

Liquor licensing begins with the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission. You may reach them at 361/575-4776.

Open records are kept by the City of Victoria. To get information, you must fill out a Request for Information form.

Birth Certificates



Birth certificates are documents necessary for identification the rest of a child's life.

- **Local** birth certificates cost \$23.00.
- **Non-local** birth certificates (from other counties within Texas) cost \$23.00.
- **Wallet** sized birth certificates cost \$23.00.
- **A picture identification** must be presented when requesting a birth certificate. This can be a driver's license or work identification card. If you don't have picture identification, then you must have two other forms of identification. One of those must have your signature.
- **All** birth certificates are closed records for seventy-five years.

Spelling Corrections

Spelling corrections on birth certificates require a completed Standard Amendment form and \$37.00 mailed to:

Death Certificates

Death certificates are also vital documents necessary for obtaining death benefits and for genealogical records.

- **Within Victoria** – Death certificates for individuals dying in Victoria cost \$21.00 for the first copy. Additional copies requested at the same time as the first request are \$4.00 per copy. Call 361/485-3040 for more information
- **A picture identification** of the person requesting the death certificate must be presented. This can be a driver's license or work identification card with a photograph. If you don't have picture identification, then you must have two other forms of identification. One of those must have your signature.
- **Outside Victoria** – Death certificates for individuals dying outside the City of Victoria, but in Victoria County, are located at the County Clerk's office. You can reach this office by calling 361/575-1478. Effective January 1, 2004 all death certificates filed after that date will be on file in the City Secretary's Office.
- **All** death certificates are closed records for twenty-five years.



Paternity (Adding the Father's Name)

Adding a father's name to your child's birth records requires special documents.

- **If the parents have married since the birth of the child** a certified copy of your marriage license is required, a completed amendment form signed by both parents and notarized. Also, send \$47.00 along with the documents to:

- **If the addition is by Court Order** you need a certified copy of the Court Order and a completed amendment form signed by one parent and notarized. Send the documents and \$47.00 to the address above.
- **If the addition is by voluntary acknowledgment** you need a completed Acknowledgment of Paternity form signed by both parents and a completed amendment form signed by both parents and notarized. Send the documents and \$47.00 to the address shown above.
