Where in the City of Victoria can you dive in, take a hike, or get hitched? You can enjoy these activities and many more at the various parks located throughout Victoria. Many residents and visitors are surprised to learn there are 15 parks that grace our beautiful city. In total, the parks comprise a little over 760 acres that provide recreational activities ranging from aquatics and playgrounds to fishing and golf.

The city parks vary in size and offer amenities such as children's playground equipment, walking and biking trails, a swimming complex, basketball, volleyball and tennis courts, softball fields, picnic tables and covered shelters.



Situated on 565 acres, Riverside Park is Victoria's largest and most popular park for outdoor recreation. Riverside features a 27-hole golf course, the Texas Zoo, hike/bike/jogging trails, playgrounds, volleyball and basketball courts, lighted ball fields, a duck pond, rose garden, nature trail, an RV park, a public boat ramp, rodeo arena, several picnic areas and covered shelters.

Victoria Memorial Rose Garden



The Memorial Rose Garden was opened in 1980. The circular design of the garden reveals a picturesque garden with a gazebo surrounded by circle beds of roses and elegantly enhanced with a water fountain. There are over 100 varieties of roses and 1,300 rose bushes. The beauty of the roses entices many to leisurely stroll among its bushes to enjoy the wondrous fragrance they emit. DeLeon Plaza

DeLeon Plaza, a centerpiece of downtown Victoria and one of the city's oldest parks, is included in the National Register of Historic Places. Forty-seven trees consisting of six different species cover the Plaza grounds, including Live Oak, Elm, Pecan, Ash, Magnolia and Redwood. The Victorian bandstand, a focal point of the historical park, is a popular site for outdoor concerts and weddings. DeLeon Plaza also serves as a venue for Market Days, seasonal celebrations and many other festivities.



Market Days

Victoria Market Days is held every 3rd Saturday between the months of March-May and October-December at DeLeon Plaza from 9am-4pm. This event enables various vendors to display their wares of arts & crafts, jewelry, woodworking, pottery, metal work and much more. There are even children's activities, food and refreshments.
