

GARBAGE PICKUP TIPS



Residential Garbage Collection

Residential garbage collection starts at 7:00 a.m.

When discarding waste:

- Containers must be placed on or near the curb line and/or edge of street on the scheduled day of collection.
- Containers must not overflow and/or have protruding objects beyond the top of the container.
- Place containers at least five (5) feet away from vehicles and/or other obstructions.
- Refuse must not be wedged tightly in container. For safety reasons, collection personnel are not permitted to reach into tightly filled containers to loosen refuse.
- Residential containers, bags or boxes should not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds.
- No containers, by law, should remain at the curb after 8:00 p.m. on the day of garbage pickup or prior to 8:00 p.m. on the day BEFORE the scheduled pickup day.
- Acids, toxins, motor oil, oil filters, gasoline, paint, pool chemicals, hot coals, or other household hazardous waste cannot, by law, be collected as refuse. It is dangerous and unlawful to dump hazardous waste or toxins in the trash or the landfill.
- Building and construction materials, auto parts, cement or rocks cannot be picked up the collection crew.

We pick up on holidays!

The City of Victoria now provides collection on city holidays which include:

- Memorial Day
- Labor Day
- Veteran's Day
- the day after Thanksgiving Day

No garbage collection is scheduled on the following days:

- Good Friday
- Independence Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Eve and Christmas day (depending on the day it falls on)

Tree Limb Collection

You must call to make an appointment for large amounts of tree limbs to be collected in your area one week per month.
