**City Closing Santa Rosa Street for Utility Work September 8**

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City is reducing Moody Street to two-lane, two-way traffic between Juan Linn Street and Constitution Street and closing Santa Rosa Street to through traffic between Glass Street and Moody Street, beginning Tuesday, September 8, to make a water line connection. This work is expected to take approximately one day, weather permitting.

All parking lots on Santa Rosa Street between Glass Street and Moody Street will be accessible via Glass Street.

The City has taken measures to reduce the inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists by limiting the area the contractor may disturb at any one time, however, drivers may experience delays in area. Alternate routes are suggested if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2,913,062 Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. This project is expected to take approximately 8 months to complete.
