No On-Street Parking Allowed on Constitution Street between Main Street and Bridge Street Starting September 8

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City will prohibit on-street parking on Constitution Street between Main and Bridge Streets, beginning Tuesday, September 8, to install a sanitary sewer line. The construction is expected to take approximately one week, weather permitting.

Two-way traffic will be maintained and pedestrians will have access to the First Victoria National Bank building during construction.

The City has taken measures to reduce the inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists by limiting the area the contractor may disturb at any one time. Drivers may still experience delays in the work zone. Alternate routes are suggested if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2.9-million Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. This project is expected to take approximately 8 months to complete.
