Santa Rosa Street between Williams Street and Main Street Narrowed to One Lane Starting September 8

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City is narrowing Santa Rosa Street between William and Main Streets to one-lane, one-way eastbound traffic beginning Tuesday, September 8, to install utilities.

Construction on Santa Rosa Street is expected to take about two weeks, weather permitting. The Wells Fargo Bank drive-through will remain open. A flagman will control access.

The intersection of Liberty and Santa Rosa Streets will close for short periods during construction. These two blocks of Santa Rosa Street will have limited on-street parking during construction.

The City has taken measures to reduce the inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists by limiting the area the contractor can disturb at any one time. Drivers may experience major delays in the work zone. Alternate routes are suggested if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2.9-million Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. This project is expected to take approximately eight months to complete.
