**Main Street Reduced to One-Lane Southbound at
Santa Rosa Street and Juan Linn Street in the
Evening Beginning August 5**

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City will reduce Main Street to one lane southbound on Wednesday, August 5, to determine potential utility conflicts at the following intersections:

Main Street at Santa Rosa Street
Main Street at Juan Linn Street

East-west traffic on Santa Rosa Street and Juan Linn Street will be allowed via flagmen. The construction at these intersections will be between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. and is expected to take three to four days, weather permitting.

To reduce inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists, the City is limiting the contractor's work area. Drivers can expect major delays in the work zone. Alternate routes are suggested if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2,913,062 Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. It is estimated that this project will take approximately 8 months to complete.
