**Bridge Street Reduced To One-Lane Northbound  
from Constitution Street to Forest Street Beginning August 5**

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City will reduce Bridge Street to one lane northbound from Constitution Street to Forest Street Wednesday, August 5, to install utilities. The construction on Bridge Street is expected to take approximately two weeks, weather permitting. On-street parking will be limited.

To reduce inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists, the City is limiting the contractor's work area. Drivers can expect major delays in the work zone. Alternate routes are suggested if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2,913,062 Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. It is estimated that this project will take approximately 8 months to complete.
