**Goodwin Street To Be Reduced To One-Lane Westbound
from Bridge Street to Glass Street Beginning July 27, 2009**

(VICTORIA, TEXAS) The City will reduce Goodwin Street to one lane westbound from Bridge Street to Glass Street on Monday, July 27, 2009 in order to install utilities. The construction on Goodwin Street is expected to take approximately one week, weather permitting. There will be no on-street parking allowed in the construction zone.

Although the City has taken measures to reduce the inconvenience to businesses, residents and motorists by limiting the length of street the contractor can work at any one time, drivers can expect major delays in the work zone and should use alternate routes to get around the work zone if possible.

This construction is part of the \$2,913,062 Downtown Water and Sewer Line Replacements (Phase I, Projects 1 & 2). The contractor performing the work is Triple B Services, LLP from Huffman, Texas. This project is projected to take approximately 8 months to complete.
