

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids addressed to the City of Victoria, Purchasing Department, will be received by mail or other forms of delivery at the Purchasing Department at 1201 E. Pine Street, Victoria, Texas 77901 until **1:30 p.m., February 8, 2012**. After 1:30 p.m. contractors will have to hand deliver their bids to the **City of Victoria 700 Main Center, 702 N. Main Street, Suite 204, Victoria, Texas 77901** until **2:00 p.m.**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing all plant, labor, material and equipment, and performing all work required to complete the **Ethel Lee Tracy Park Amphitheater** to be located at 701 East Larkspur Street, Victoria, Texas 77904. Bids received after 2:00 p.m. will not be accepted.

The Instructions for Bidders, Bid Form, Plans, Specifications and other Contract Documents may be secured from the Architect, Rawley McCoy and Associates PLLC, 1908 N. Laurent St., Suite 540, Victoria, Texas 77901 for a deposit of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) made payable to the Architect. The one hundred and fifty dollar (\$150.00) deposit will be refunded to all persons returning sets within ten days of bid opening and in good condition.

The City reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with its bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions in the Instructions to Bidders.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

No bidder may withdraw its bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
