Frequently asked questions -

Q. How much does it cost?

A. Nothing - a sponsor picks up the tab for everything.

Q. Does the Academy lead to a job in law enforcement?

A. No, it's not a training course for that.

Q. How many classes are there?

A. 11 classes are for 3 hours on Tuesday nights. Plus, there are two Saturday mornings for Building Searches and Firearms instruction days.

Q. Who instructs in the Academy?

A. A lot of different people, including more than 20 different police officers, plus other criminal justice professionals.



Q. What do the classes consist of?

A. A host of things, some indoors and some outside. There are tours of the County Jail, and the 911 Center.

There are simulated building searches & traffic stops, as well as a ride-along with an officer on duty, a tour of a patrol car, a search and handcuffing exercise, plus a session on the firearms range designed for the skilled & the unskilled student.

Come join the fun! This class promises to be an exciting, rewarding experience. Once you graduate, you are eligible to join the *Civilian Police Academy Alumni Association*, and can serve as a police volunteer to help in a variety of law enforcement projects and activities.
