

Proposition C

Amending the Charter of the City of Victoria to provide that all current and future elected officials are ineligible to serve in the same office for a period of one year after serving four (4) consecutive elected terms in that office.

Measure C

ARTICLE II. - THE CITY COUNCIL

Section 3. - Mayor elected at large, Councilmembers elected from districts, terms of members.

No current or future elected official shall serve more than four (4) consecutive terms of office. For purposes of this section “office” shall be defined as an individual district place and the position of Mayor. Years or time of service that an official may serve in filling an unexpired term or a partial term of an office, to which they were appointed, shall not be counted toward the above limitations. Years or time of service that an official may serve in filling a full term, an unexpired term or a partial term of an office, to which they were elected, shall be counted as a full term toward the above limitations. Terms of service in one office shall not count towards the term of service in another office. A person who has reached the limitation on terms provided in this section shall not be eligible for election or appointment to the same office for a period of one year from the date of the canvas of the election of their final term.
