Technical Advisory Committee Annual Meeting Minutes  
November 4, 2009**

Marie Lester welcomed everyone and had everyone introduce themselves.

Jerry James gave an update on legislative issues. Victoria usually receives just under \$1 million every other year from the state. EPA may set the AQI standard lower which would place Victoria in non-attainment status. TCEQ is helping promote better communication among the air quality programs.

Marie Lester updated on EPA reconsidering ozone standards and how it will affect Victoria. Our average ozone level to date for 2009 is 65ppb and in 2008 it was 66ppb. If the EPA lowers its standard to between 60ppb and 70ppb Texas could have up to 27 counties that are in non-attainment. The final reconsideration will be August 2010 and the final designation will be August 2011. The state implementation plan is due December 2013. The state implementation plan revision proposal measures are:

- Tailor Air Victoria's public outreach campaign to focus on new contingency measures
- Evaluate impact of proposed contingency measures
- Control rich-burn, gas-fired, reciprocating internal combustion engines
- Control of crude and condensate storage tanks
- Controls for tank fittings on floating roof tanks
- Limit emissions from landings of floating roofs
- Control of VOC emissions from degassing operations for storage tanks
- TxLED for marine diesel

Gary McGaughey and Cyril Durrenberger gave presentations on 2002 Seasonal Model Development and Technical Projects in the draft work plan for FY 2010-2011.

After open discussion on presentations, meeting was adjourned.
